Abe Lincoln	Heirloom	Beefsteak	late	Red	Indeterminate	Released in 1923; 8-10 oz. fruit
Amana Orange	Heirloom	Beefsteak	late	Orange	Indeterminate	Sweet flavor; 2+lb fruit
Amish Paste	Heirloom	Paste	late	Red	Indeterminate	8 oz fruit; oblong; sweet flavor
Brandywine	Heirloom	Beefsteak	late	Pink	Indeterminate	Large fruit (approx. 1 lb.); "very rich, loud, and distinctively spicy" flavor
Brandywine Red Landis	Heirloom	Beefsteak	mid	Red	Indeterminate	8 oz fruit; originated in PA in 1885
Bush Beefsteak	Hybrid	Beefsteak	early	Red	Determinate	Early compact plant with big cluster of 6-8 oz fruit
Cherokee Purple	Heirloom	Beefsteak	late	Deep Pink	Indeterminate	Very sweet flavor; has green shoulders
Clear Pink Early	Heirloom	Slicing	early	Pink	Determinate	Russian origin; 4-6 oz fruit
Early Wonder	Heirloom	Slicing	early	Red	Determinate	Introduced in 1950; 6 oz fruit; good for container gardening
Fireworks	Hybrid	Slicing	early	Red	Indeterminate	One of the largest early, best tasting slicing tomato, 6-8 oz fruit
Gardener's Delight	Hybrid	Cherry	mid	Red	Indeterminate	Bite size, extra sweet, very prolific
German Johnson	Heirloom	Slicing	late	pink	Indeterminate	From Virginia/North Carolina; averages 1 lb fruit
Green Giant	Heirloom	Slicing	late	green	Indeterminate	Sweet spicy flavor; 12 - 18 oz fruit
Gregori's Altai	Heirloom	Beefsteak	mid	Pink/Red	Indeterminate	From the Altai mountains near Siberia; 8-12 oz fruit
Independence Day or Fourth of July	Hybrid	Slicing	early	Red	Indeterminate	One of the earliest varieties, yielding fruit around the 4th of July; small fruit between the size of a tennis and golf ball; good taste for an early variety; prolific producer until frost
Jubilee	Heirloom	Slicing	mid	Yellow	Indeterminate	1943 All American Selection Winner; 6-7 oz., 3" low acid fruit; Has green shoulders
Juliet	Hybrid	Grape	early	Red	Indeterminate	1999 All American Selection; Twice the size of most grape tomatoes; great salad/salsa tomato
Kalman's Hungarian Pink	Heirloom	Paste	late	pink	Indeterminate	originated in Europe; pink juicy paste; 8 oz fruit
Legend	Hybrid	Slicing	early	Red	Determinate	Developed by Oregon State U; disease resistant
Marglobe	Heirloom	Slicing	mid	Scarlet	Determinate	Released by USDA in 1925; 8-10oz globe shaped fruit
Mortgage Lifter	Heirloom	Beefsteak	late	Pink	Indeterminate	Mild flavor; can be somewhat mealy
Orange Slice	h	Beefsteak	mid	Orange	Indeterminate	16 oz fruit; juicy and flavorful
Oregon Spring	Hybrid	Slicing	early	Red	Determinate	Nearly seedless; Fruits weigh 3-5 oz.; good for sauces, ketchup
Phoenix	Hybrid	Slicing	mid	Red	Determinate	Heat & disease resistant; large harvest of 8 oz fruit
Red Cherry	Heirloom	Cherry	mid	Red	Indeterminate	The classic cherry tomato; Fruits are 1.25" in diameter
Red Oxheart or Hungarian Heart	Heirloom	Slicing	late	Pinkish-Red	Indeterminate	From the 1920's; heart-shaped; very meaty, sweet, juicy flavor
Roma VF	Hybrid	Paste	mid	Red	Determinate	Old popular variety for paste. Meaty thick walls with few seeds
Russian Rose	Heirloom	Slicing	mid	pink	Indeterminate	Russian heirloom ; meaty 12 oz fruit
Rutgers	Heirloom	Slicing	mid	Red	Indeterminate	Developed in the 1930's by Rutgers University for the canning industry; large, red fruits with thick flesh
Speckled Roman	Hybrid	Paste	late	Orange/Red	Indeterminate	5 inch meaty paste tomato; 6-8 oz fruit
Sub-Artic Plenty	Heirloom	Slicing	early	Red	Determinate	One of the earliest tomatoes; 1"-2" fruit; Allegedly developed in the 1940's by the US military to provide fresh tomatoes to the troops in Greenland
Super Beefsteak	Hybrid	Beefsteak	late	Red	Indeterminate	Large, meaty fruits; grow to at least 1 lb.; superior disease & crack resistance
Thessaloniki	Hybrid	Slicing	mid	Red	Indeterminate	Greek variety; good yield; tasty 6-8 oz fruit
Viva Italia	Hybrid	Paste	mid	Red	Determinate	3 oz fruits; developed for cooking, canning, freezing; vigorous grower; high sugar content
Yellow Brandywine	Heirloom	Beefsteak	late	Yellow	Indeterminate	Rich tasing 12 - 24 oz fruit
Yellow Pear	Heirloom	Cherry	mid	Yellow	Indeterminate	Bite-sized 1-2 inch tangy fruit; plants are large & sprawling and require staking
